How to move 2 x 50 ts generators up to the mountains of Costa Rica

Two 50.5 tons generators, part of a Hydro Power plant project in Upala / Costa Rica, have been successfully moved from Spain to final destination in the mountains of Costa Rica by Conceptum Logistics.

To guarantee a smooth operation, a lot of arrangements had to be made beforehand:

- One month advance application for duty exoneration through consignee, based on complete and final documentation
- Pre-import clearance at Puerto Moin to avoid high bonded warehouse costs and transport delay
- The two generators have been lifted from break-bulk vessel onto trailers directly by vessel gear due to limited lifting capacity at Costa Rica ports after the arrival.

Regarding on-carriage to the final destination several challenges had to be faced:

- Route study into mountainous hinterland
- Bridge study and its enforcement
- Tug master reservation for pulling trucks uphill to jobsite

Due to customs coordination and infrastructure in Costa Rica this was a complex operation. However, we achieved a successful result.
